July 27

- **1976:** Tina Turner filed for divorce from Ike Turner, ending their 16-year abusive marriage and launching her path to solo stardom.
- **1976:** Bruce Springsteen sued his former manager Mike Appel for fraud and breach of trust, halting his recording career for over a year.
- **1983:** Metallica kicked off their very first major tour—the *Kill 'Em All for One* tour—supporting the band Raven.
- **1986:** Queen played a massive concert for 80,000 fans at the Népstadion in Budapest, Hungary, becoming one of the first Western rock acts to perform behind the Iron Curtain.
